



## Local group 'shattered' by boat ramp development

**A group opposed to the construction of a new boat ramp near Mallacoota says it is shattered by a council decision to support the development.**

The East Gippsland Council last night voted in favour of sending plans for the Bastion Point boat ramp to Environment Minister Gavin Jennings for final approval.

The motion was carried five to three.

James Thyer from the Save Bastion Point group says its concerns about the harbour development have been ignored.

"It's a very destructive development, it actually destroys the surfing potential of Bastion Point," he said.

"It's very environmentally intrusive and will have a huge impact on the recreational usage of the beach."

The group will approach Mr Jennings with an alternative proposal to the harbour development.
