Dreary weather didn't dampen the spirits of Mallacoota residents and their fellow Save Bastion Point campaigners who gathered in Main Street, Bairnsdale, yesterday afternoon to march to the East Gippsland Shire Council offices and present a postcard petition. The postcard – with a seven-figure postage stamp attached – was carried by one of two white elephants present for the rally. Slightly diminutive compared to its big cousin, a human-sized specimen was charged with carrying the petition and led a contingent of around 50 in a march from the Pyke Street corner. Signatures were gathered at a rally at Bastion Point Beach over the Easter break and express the community's disapproval of the 'Option 3B' ocean access proposal. K267-104
